Recruitment to the post of Insurance Medical Officer in Junior Class-I (Group-A) of Orissa E.S.I. Medical Services Cadre under Labour & Employment Department

Applications in the prescribed form are invited from the prospective candidates for recruitment to 39 (thirty-nine) posts of Insurance Medical Officer in Junior Class-I (Group-A) of Orissa E.S.I. Medical Services Cadre under Labour & Employment Department in the pay band of Rs.15,600-39,100/- plus grade pay Rs.5,400/- with usual dearness and other allowances sanctioned by Government of Orissa from time to time. The posts are temporary and likely to be made permanent.

- (a) Out of the vacancies mentioned above, 01 (one) post is reserved for Physically Handicapped (Orthopaedically Handicapped) candidates, having the disability such as O.A. (one arm affected), OL (one leg affected), BL (both legs affected) having standing ability, who are capable of rendering service to the public; 01 (one) post is reserved for Ex-servicemen and 01 (one) post is reserved for Sports persons. Candidates belonging to P.H. (Ortho.), Ex-servicemen & Sports Persons shall be adjusted against the categories to which they belong.
- (b) In the event of non-availability or availability of insufficient number of eligible and suitable women candidate(s) belonging to any particular category, the vacancies or the remaining vacancies will be filled up by male candidates of that category.
- (c) The number of vacancies to be filled up on the basis of this recruitment is subject to change by Government without notice, depending upon the exigencies of public service at the discretion of the State Government.

3. JOB CHART - To provide medical care to the insured persons and their family members.

4. AGE : A candidate must be under 32 (thirty-two) years and above 21 (twenty-one) years of age on the 1st January, 2010.

The upper age limit is relaxable by 5(five) years for candidates belonging to Socially & Educationally Backward Classes (S.E.B.C.), Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Women and Ex-Servicemen and by 10(ten) years for Physically Handicapped candidates (Orthopaedically Handicapped).

Provided that, a candidate coming under more than one category mentioned above will be eligible for only one age relaxation benefit, which shall be considered most beneficial to him/her.

Provided further that, in respect of a candidate serving under E.S.I. Scheme, Orissa, the period of past service rendered as Insurance Medical Officer by the last date of receipt of application shall be added to the age limit prescribed for entry in to the Government service.

SAVE AS PROVIDED ABOVE, THE AGE LIMITS PRESCRIBED CAN IN NO CASE BE RELAXED.

Date of birth entered in the High School certificate or equivalent certificate issued by the concerned Board/Council will only be accepted by the Commission.

5. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION :

- (i) A candidate must be a Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (M.B.B.S.) from any recognized university in the Indian Union or possess equivalent qualification or be a holder of a registrable medical qualification from a recognized medical college in United Kingdom.
- (ii) After passing the final M.B.B.S. examination from any recognised university, where M.B.B.S. course is of 4 ½ years duration, a candidate must have successfully completed housemanship for at least one year. But if a candidate has passed the final M.B.B.S. examination of five years course from any other recognised university, where there is no obligatory rotating housemanship prior to award of the M.B.B.S. degree, he/she must have completed housemanship successfully for at least six months on or before the last date prescribed for receipt of application for the above post.
- (iii) In case he/she has acquired M.B.B.S. degree from a foreign university, he/she is required to have passed the screening test conducted by the National Board of Examination as prescribed by the Medical Council of India vide Notification No.MCI-203(9) Regn.2001, dated 13.02.2002.
- (iv) A candidate before appointment will have to register himself/herself under the Orissa Medical Registration Act, 1961, if not, already so registered.

6. HOW TO APPLY : (a) (i) **Application Form :** Candidates are required to apply to the Secretary to the Commission in the prescribed form which, along with other particulars, are obtainable in person from the Office of the Orissa Public Service Commission, 19, Dr. P.K. Parija Road, Cuttack-753001 between 11.00 A.M. to 1.30 P.M. and 2.00 P.M. to 4.00 P.M. on any working day on cash payment of Rs.30/- (Rupees thirty) only or by speed/registered post on remittance of Rs.70/- (Rupees seventy) only by money order. Full name and address of the candidate, advertisement number and name of the Post/Service advertised must be specified in the money-order coupon in **BOLD CAPITAL LETTERS**.

(ii) **If Money-Order from any candidate for supply of prescribed application form is received in the office of the O.P.S.C. after the last date for receipt of applications, no application form will be supplied to such candidate;**

(iii) The candidates may also download the prescribed application form and copy of long advertisement from the website of the O.P.S.C., i.e. <http://opsc.nic.in>. The S.E.B.C. candidates downloading the application form will be required to pay Rs.80/- (Rs.30/- for prescribed application form + Rs.50/- towards examination fee) only in shape of Indian postal order/bank draft/pay order/treasury challan as provided under paragraph-7 of the long advertisement at the time of submission of application form. The S.C./S.T. candidates downloading the prescribed application form will be required to pay Rs.30/- towards prescribed application form only in shape of Indian Postal Order/Bank Draft/Pay Order/Treasury Challan, as the case may be, at the time of submission of application form. The S.C./S.T. candidates are, however, exempted from paying the examination fee.

(iv) **Submission of applications :** Candidates are required to send their applications in prescribed form by registered post/speed post/courier service to the Secretary, Orissa Public Service Commission, 19, Dr. P.K. Parija Road, Cuttack-753001. **The Commission will not take any responsibility if the application is not received in time.** The candidates may also submit their application in **closed covers** in the Office of Orissa Public Service Commission directly/personally on or before the last date of receipt of applications at the counter. The closed envelope containing the application must be superscribed "**Application for Insurance Medical Officer**". The candidates submitting their applications directly/personally at the counter of Orissa Public Service Commission will be given proper acknowledgement receipt;

7. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF APPLICATIONS -

On receipt of application of a candidate, the acknowledgement card (Post Card in case of down loaded application form) submitted by him/her along with the application, will be despatched by the Commission's office to him/her. The mere fact that a candidate's application has been acknowledged by the Commission, does not mean that his/her candidature for the recruitment has been accepted by the Commission.
